What: Dinner Auction Grand Raffle

When: *19th Annual Spirit of ND Dinner Auction - April 23, 2010*
Drawing during the Live Auction
Eight Raffle Books sent home to families week of March 8th - additional raffle books are available at school

Where: The Dinner Auction, hosted by the ND College Prep *President's Office, Parents' Association and Alumni Association*, will be held at St. John Brebeuf Ministry Center in Niles

Why: Tuition covers only 80% of Notre Dame's annual expenses. The difference between tuition and the cost of education per student is a tuition grant awarded to each student. Funding for this tuition grant is covered through fundraising efforts involving our entire Notre Dame family at events like the Dinner Auction. The auction works to raise funds to support daily operations as well as initiatives in academic programs, technology, financial assistance, faculty and staff professional development and capital improvements.

GRAND RAFFLE INFORMATION

Ticket Cost:

Grand Raffle tickets cost \$5 a piece or \$25 for a booklet. Raffle books contain 6 tickets each.

Family Quota:

Each Notre Dame FAMILY is being asked to sell 4 raffle books, or \$100 worth of chances. If a family wishes to be entered in the Tuition Raffle, they are asked to sell 8 books, or \$200 worth of chances.

Student Incentives:

Students who reach their quota and turn in \$100 worth of chances are eligible for the student incentive raffle. For each \$100 turned in; their name will be entered into the raffle. A prize of \$100 cash will be drawn each week and the grand prize will be drawn the night of the auction. The grand prize is \$500 in cash.

Family Incentives:

If a family sells \$200 worth of raffle tickets, they will be entered in the Tuition Raffle Drawing. Three winners will become eligible to win:

**\$2,000 toward Notre Dame tuition for 2010-2011 or*

** For graduating seniors, \$2,000 will be applied to their college tuition*

To be entered in the Tuition Drawing, a family MUST have sold \$200 and submitted their money by the April 22nd collection day at the latest!

Early Quota Bonus Plan:

When a family turns in \$200 by:

**Friday, March 12, they receive 7 EXTRA CHANCES for Drawing*

**Thursday, March 18, they receive 5 EXTRA CHANCES for Drawing*

**Friday, March 26, they receive 3 EXTRA CHANCES for Drawing*

**Friday, April 16, they receive 1 EXTRA CHANCE for Drawing*

Collections:

All Grand Raffle monies will be collected at school on Friday, March 12, Thursday, March 18, Friday, March 26, Friday, April 16 and Thursday, April 22. Payment by check, rather than cash, would be appreciated. Please make checks payable to:
