- ❑ **Big Shoulders Fund** provides support for students attending Catholic schools. Applications are accepted through the grade schools. Contact the school's principal or counselor for more information. Visit www.bigshoulderfund.org
 - ❑ **Chicago Lights** scholarships enable selected students to attend Chicago-area private and parochial high school. Contact the Director of Tutoring for more information. Visit www.chicagolights.org
 - ❑ **Daniel Murphy Scholarship Foundation** which provides four-year academic scholarships to economically disadvantaged Chicagoland eighth grade students to attend private college preparatory high schools. Visit www.dmsf.org.
