Bob Z expressed concern that there were not enough alums in attendance at the meeting. He would like to see the agenda and minutes distributed in advance of the meeting so that members are better able to participate. He feels that the association needs to get more organized. Bob suggested that everyone in attendance should call five people before every meeting to spark attendance.

Bill Harrington also conveyed disappointment that more people are not involved. He believes that 100s of additional alums should be involved, and that class reps need to make a commitment to attend the meetings. Bill remarked that the association is looking to the Board to be leaders, and that the members would follow the Board's lead. However, the Board needs a better plan moving forward. We need to make meetings more enjoyable.

Gene stated that the problem may be poor communication. Meeting information needs to be much more targeted, and needs to be conveyed in a variety of media.

Mike Sweeney said that he and others would be willing to help, but specific requests need to be made.
